



In front of the hotel is the ancient footpath which takes you to the La Verna Sanctuary, international religious centre where St. Francis of Assisi received the stigma in 1224. The trail is part of the "Walk of St. Francis" which from Assisi leads to Verna passing through the impressive forest. Chiusi della Verna is within the Casentino Forests, Monte Falterona and Campigna National Park and there are numerous itineraries in a natural territory which changes with each season. Just a few kilometers away is Casentino and Valtiberina, where small towns, churches and castles tell the rich history of this land.
